6th Russbach Workshop on Nuclear Astrophysics

we are pleased to announce the 6th Russbach Workshop on Nuclear Astrophysics, to be held from March 2 through 6, 2009 in Russbach am Pass Gschütt, Dachstein West, Austria.

This year, the conference is hosted by the Max-Planck Institut für Chemie, Otto-Hahn-Institut, Mainz, Germany and the Nuclear Physics Group of GANIL, Caen, France.

Keeping its tradition, the workshop will provide a discussion forum on various experimental and theoretical topics in astrophysics, astronomy, cosmochemistry and nuclear structure, with the aim to raise mutual interest and to teach students and young postdocs in the truely interdisciplinary realm of "nuclear astrophysics".

The workshop will again be organized in sessions of lectures and short(er) contributions, with ample time for discussions and small working groups on specific subjects.

In addition to the lectures, 20 - 30 min contributions by students and postdocs will be selected for presentation.

We have again be able to negotiate a good price for the accomodation at several hotels and pensions in Russbach. The costs will be about 300 EUR, covering 6 days double-room accomodation on half-board. Only a limited number of single rooms will be available with a surcharge. For families with children, we will try to provide (a few) appartments.

Payments can be done by EC-card, cheque, IBAN money order or cash before departure.

In addition a small workshop fee of 70 EUR for senior scientists and post-docs, and 30 EUR for students will be charged in cash at arrival. Most of

this fee is to cover the rent of the lecture room, coffee breaks and (if necessary) local transportation.

A limited number of grants is foreseen, and priorities will be given to students and young postdocs. You are herewith encouraged to send requests for partial financial support (estimated amount in EUR) to the organizers.
