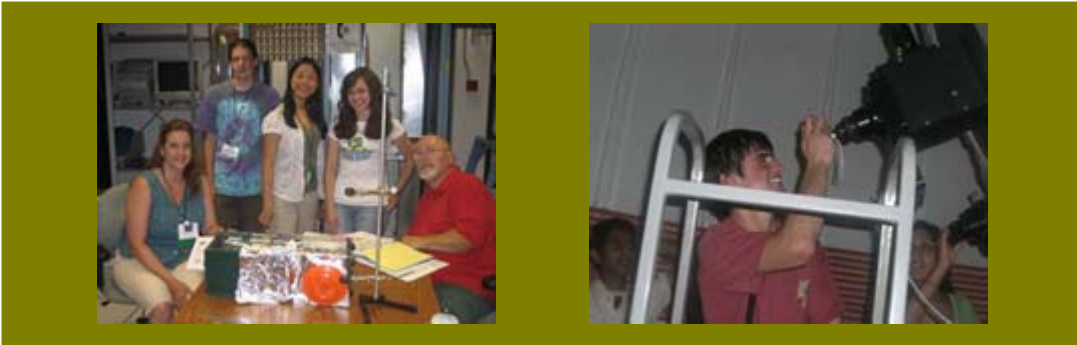


Physics of the Atomic Nuclei (PAN) Program @ MSU 2007
